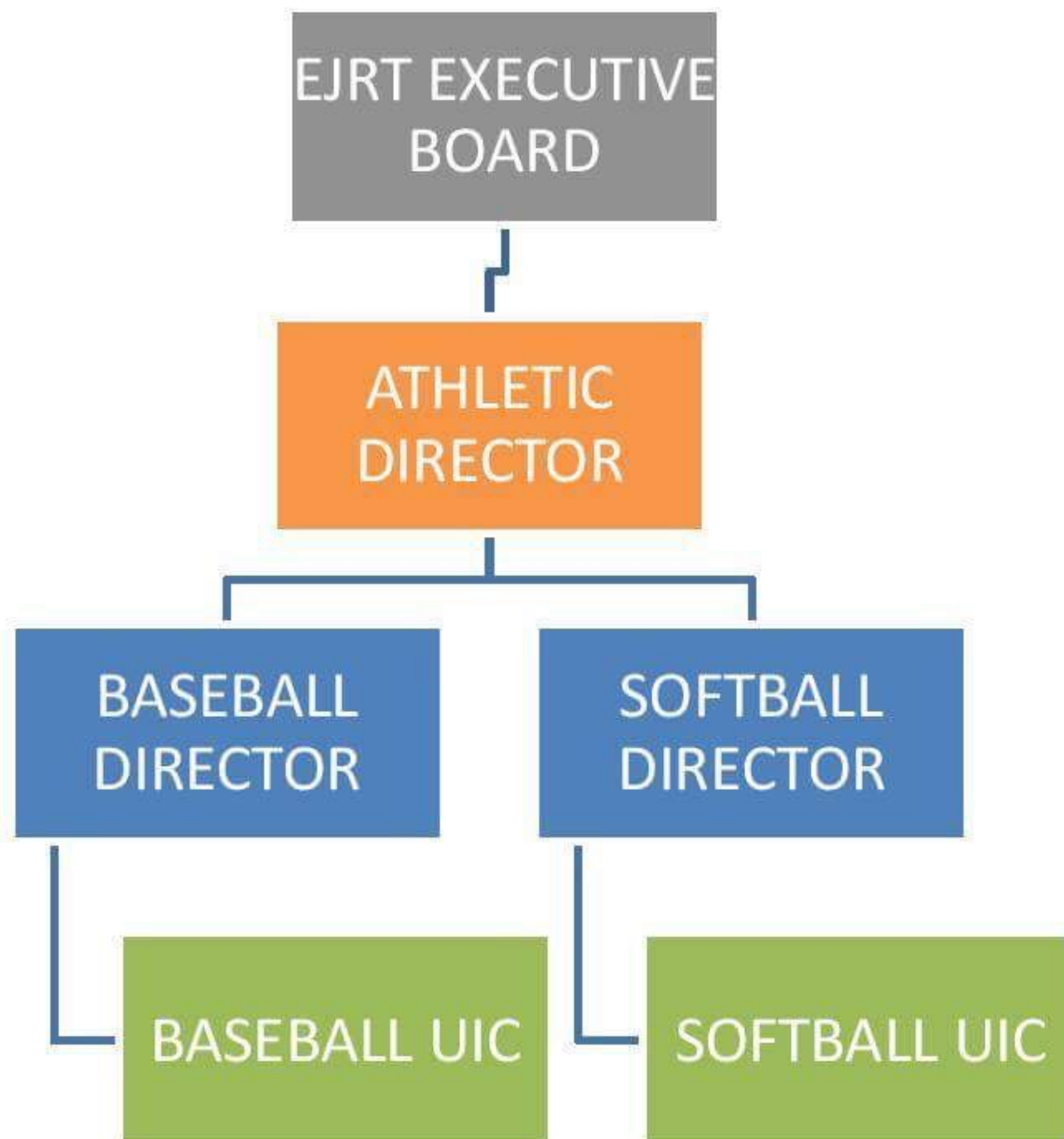


# EJRT APPEAL PROCESS



## Ejection:

If a player, coach or parent is ejected by the Athletic Director, Baseball Director, Softball Director, Umpire in Charge or an umpire the following procedure has been established.

- **First Ejection:** The player, coach or parent is ejected from that game. The parent, player or coach will be required to leave the complex.
- **Second Ejection:** The player, coach or parent is ejected for the current game and two subsequent games.
- **Third Ejection:** The player, coach or parent will not be permitted back on the EJRT premises for the remainder of the season.

If a player, coach or parent is ejected as outlined above that person is entitled to an appeal process. If the player, coach or parent is ejected by an official or umpire in charge the initial level of appeal will be to the Baseball or Softball Director. The appeal will be submitted in writing within 48 hours of the ejection. If the appeal is not submitted within the 48 hours there will not be an appeal for that event. If after the appeal the ejected person is not satisfied with the outcome the person is entitled to submit a formal appeal to the Athletic Director. Again, this must be submitted in writing and within 48 hours of the previous ruling. If the appeal is not submitted within the 48 hours the appeal will be determined to be rectified and closed.

If a player, coach or parent is ejected by either the Baseball Director or Softball Director the first level of appeal will be to the Athletic Director. The appeal will be submitted in writing within 48 hours of the ejection. If the appeal is not submitted within the 48 hours there will not be an appeal for that event.

If the ejected player, coach or parent does not agree with the Athletic Director the final appeal can be made to the EJRT Executive Board. This will be done in the same manner as the other appeals. The decision made by the EJRT Executive Board will be final.
